### MK Soup

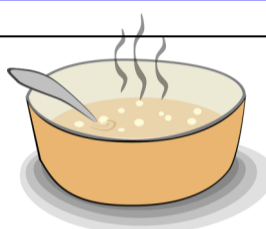
HOW SOUP WORKS:
